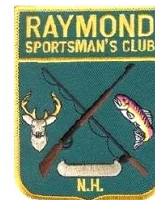
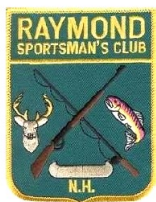

### New Sign

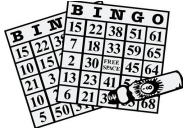

# Raymond Sportsman's Club Annual Bingo Event



Once again, we are approaching our town's biggest summer celebration.... The 49th annual Raymond Town Fair. The Raymond Sportsman's Club Bingo Tent is actually the fair's patriarch event. If you have never participated in this event, it has proven to be a terrific opportunity to meet and get to know your fellow RSC members. This 3-day event is also Raymond Sportsman's Club's only real exposure to the community of Raymond annually, so we do our best to create a welcome venue for our patrons.

This bingo event is one of the club's major fund raisers, and it may surprise you to know this activity requires 300-400 member hours to make it work. The bingo event alone runs 20 hours, set up and take down accounts for another 4 hours and the 7 routes dropping off the town fair booklets to businesses in Raymond and adjoining towns, averages about 6 hours per route.

If you are curious about what titles this event logs hours for and the potential hours available, they are as follows: Town Fair booklet distribution (5-6 hrs.) Banker (up to 22 hrs.) Caller (up to 21 hrs.) and Runner/Sales (up to 22 hrs.). No one is required to work open till close, although many members choose to. Nearly 70% of the bingo team acquired their total 12 required work hours during this event in 2023.
