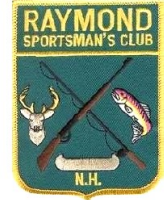
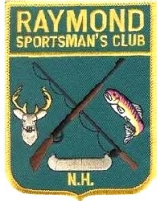

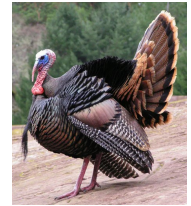
RSC 2025 Game Dinner
